Rules of

- Conduct: The MSHSL Board of Directors has approved the following rules of conduct and expects meet managers to enforce them.
 - 1. A runner shall be disqualified if a coach or other individual runs with or makes physical contact with her/him.
 - 2. Coaches must be in a restricted area designated by a chalk line behind the runners at the start of a race.
 - 3. Only personnel designated by the meet manager are permitted in the finish area.
 - 4. No mechanical sounding devices (cow bells) may be used or time splits called by anyone other than official meet personnel.
 - 5. Cell phones are not allowed in the competition area.
 - 6. In accordance with the MSHSL, runners may not have headbands that are knotted, no body markings (eye black, magic marker etc.) are allowed and uniforms must conform to the Minnesota Modifications amendment. All watches are allowed.
